Resume Guidelines for Continuing Students

Please use these guidelines when preparing your application for College of Forestry graduate scholarships. Note that only academic and professional accomplishments attained <u>during</u> your current OSU degree program should be listed. Sections that are not applicable may be omitted.

Resumes are to be prepared in 12 point font and contain the following:

- 1. Name
- 2. **Degree sought** (MS, PhD, etc.) and **degree program** (FES, SFM, etc.)
- 3. Department
- 4. **Summary of Activities and Accomplishments** restricted to those activities and accomplishments that are directly related to your current degree program. Include such things as:

A. Scholarship and Creative Activities

- a. Books and Chapters in Books
- b. Refereed Journal Articles
- c. Other Peer Reviewed Bulletins, Papers, and Notes
- d. Un-reviewed Publications
- e. Abstracts
- f. Posters
- g. Presentations
- h. Software for Regional Distribution
- i. Grants Developed and Awarded

B. Teaching Activities

- i. Credit Courses
- k. Non-credit Courses and Workshops

C. Service Activities

- I. Department, College and/or University
- m. Profession
- n. Public
- D. Awards (excluding CoF graduate scholarships)
